1. The subject meeting was called to order at 1330 7 February 2002. The following members were in attendance:

2. Discussion focused on the following items.

a. Network Drops. A network drop is a receptacle and the associated wires and hardware to enable user a connection on the network. Network connectivity allows file and printer sharing as well as email and internet access. With the addition of the new computers, there are computers that are unable to access the network. There are also computers "sharing" a drop which degrades network functionality and reliability. MID has proposed adding 26 network drops at NAVSTA facilities and 4 network drops at NAB facility at a cost of \$10,000. ISEB recommends that due to fiscal constraints, full implementation of this project cannot be funded at this time. MID shall re-prioritize the list into three priority categories and ask the vendors to bid them separately. MID will also verify that none of these requested drops are covered in the upcoming CHCS2 network implementation. See MID response attached. *Time Zone*

b. Laptops and Proximas. Most staff training is now provided to clinics on CDs. Laptops and proximas at each of the major clinics would enable the specialists to prepare and give lectures that are both interesting and valuable. Requests include:

- 1) Laptop for MCRD (already have proxima) \$2250
- 2) Laptop, Projector for Coronado \$4045
- 3) Projector for Lemoore (already have laptop) \$1795

ISEB requested to know the current locations of all existing laptops and proximas. See MID response attached.

c. MID Update.

- 1) CHCS2. BDC China Lake had 8 drops installed in January. Hueneme and Mugu are scheduled for May and San Diego area during March/May timeframe. This is just installation of networking drops and equipment. No end-user-devices (EUD) nor CHCS2 software are to be deployed at this time at these locations.
- 2) BDC Mugu is now on the base network in Ventura County. This leaves ASW as the only dial-up network access in the command.
- 3) Blackberry units have been issued to CO, XO, CMC, and Comptroller. MID will investigate the software to read attachments.
- 4) Software updates were applied to all new computers in January. This included patches for Windows 2000, Office 2000, Internet Explorer, and NAVFIT.

d. LCDR Bernard reiterated the fact that a replacement needs to be now found for DTI Fojas who will be transferring to another command this summer. POW note was written and issued declaring a need for MID assistant and the applicants should have at least one year PRD, need to submit a chit up the chain, and provide a resume detailing experience and education.

e. ADP Tech Class. Announcement has gone out and nominations are coming in. This 4-day hands-on course involves re-building a computer, connecting to the network, installing software, some software tips and tricks, and computer security. Two sessions are being offered 25-28 February and 4-7 March.

3. The meeting was adjourned at 1440.


