1. Purpose. To announce the Forty-Seventh Annual Professional Military Dental Symposium.
2. Information. The Commanding Officer, Naval Dental Center Southwest, will sponsor a Professional Military Dental Symposium on 12 May 2004 to be held at the Quality Resort Mission Valley, 875 Hotel Circle South, San Diego, California 92108.
 - a. The Program for the Symposium is outlined in enclosure (1). Table clinics are detailed in enclosure (2). Enclosure (3) is a flyer for distribution, e-mailings and posting on bulletin boards.
 - b. There will be a social period and table clinics from 1630 - 1815. A choice of Macadamia Crusted Halibut or London Broil dinner will be served at 1830, followed by an awards ceremony at 1930. The professional presentation will begin after the awards ceremony.


